09.00 AM	Visit Wat Phukhao Thong this temple is located outside the city of Ayutthaya it was built by U-Thong in 1357 for meditation in 1592 when King Naresuan defeated the Burmese crown prince, he commanded a large pagoda built at this temple to match the height pagoda Si Sanphet was then Thai capital for 417 years and after visit Viharn Phra Mongkol Bopit one of the largest bronze buddha in Thailand
09.45 AM	Arrive at Ayutthaya or Ancient city (The second capital of Thailand) visit the Ancient Palace and Wat Phra Si Sanphet
12.00 PM	Lunch at the restaurant Thai food will be served
13.00 PM	Visit Wat Lokayasutha the image of reclining buddha
14.00 PM	Visit Wat Phra Mahathat this temple is located in front of Grand Palace the construction was begun during the reign of King Borom Rachathirat in 1374 A.D.
14.20 PM	Visit Summer Palace This Royal Palace at Bang Pa-In history dating back to the 17th century according to a chronicle of Ayutthaya, Today the palace is used occasionally by their majesties King Rama IX and Queen Sirikit as a residence and for receptions and Banquets.
15.30 PM	Return from Ayutthaya
17.00 PM	Arrive to Bangkok drop in Khao San Road.
